

KINDERGARTEN

Kindergarten kicked off the month of March with Read Across America week. The students enjoyed reading stories, rhyming, and participating in dress up days. In readers workshop, students have been working on reading bigger books by using their bigger reading muscles. In writers workshop, students have been making "How To" books. Students have enjoyed using these books to teach others how to do the things they know a lot about. In math, we continued our unit on number pairs and have also been working on addition and subtraction to 10. In science, we completed our unit on materials and motion, studying a variety of materials and learning about how things move. We also spent time this month observing and describing changes as we learned about spring.

FIRST GRADE

First grade is excited to welcome Spring. We are enjoying the sunny weather and noticing that the playground has very little snow left. In math, the first graders have begun a new unit all about shapes. They are busy exploring both 2D and 3D shapes and will soon be completing work with fractions and telling time as well! Our phonics lessons are all about being word builders. First graders have been busy investigating and using vowel teams in both their reading and writing. Writer's Workshop has been filled with many opinions! First graders are learning how to put their opinions into writing to convince others. Our fingers are crossed that April showers truly bring May flowers. We are excited to see green and will begin learning all about plants and animals in our next Science unit!

SECOND GRADE

Second graders are very excited about the arrival of spring! They have been thrilled to go outside and play without all the winter gear on each day. This year has flown by and the second graders continue to learn so much each day. We are excited about all the progress they have made

In literacy we have been focusing on strategies to help us break apart longer and multisyllabic words. It is exciting to see the second graders use these strategies in their independent reading.

In writing we have been working on a special book project about ourselves. We developed paragraphs about our topics, wrote three or more sentences about each topic, and worked through the writing process to make it better. We are so excited to see the final product when it is finished!

In math we are completing our multiplication and division unit and will be moving on to a new topic soon. We will be learning how to graph data, tell time to the five minute, and how to count higher amounts of money. Any extra practice you could do at home in this area is very helpful! We are wrapping up our science unit on the states of matter and will be incorporating Jr. Achievement lessons into our classrooms. We will be learning about our community, what our community offers, needs and wants, and different types of ways to produce things. The second graders really enjoy these lessons and the activities that follow them.

THIRD GRADE

Oh my! The last month flew by! We have been busy reviewing skills and preparing for the Wisconsin State Test. Our testing days are March 29, 30, and 31st. We are looking forward to our Spring Music Concert on April 8th! See you there!

FOURTH GRADE

This month has been a busy one in Fourth Grade! We have continued our focus on fractions and will be moving into work with decimals for the month of April. Students are also enjoying learning about the Midwest region, and the great state of Wisconsin! Everyone has been excited to learn about Native American tribes that live and have lived here!

Turning to the month of April brings us to Wisconsin Forward testing and the excitement of warmer weather. Everyone is working hard in preparation for the move to 5th Grade!

FIFTH GRADE

March has been a big month for Wakanda 5th Grade! We are supremely grateful for the wonderful new additions to our 5th Grade Innovation Stations courtesy of 3M-Gives Wisconsin, 3M Menomonie, and Donors Choose. These new tools and resources will help us to think & learn like architects in our *Breaking the Box: The Architecture of Frank Lloyd Wright Project.* This integrated project taught in tandem with Wakanda Art Specialist, Sally Johnson, asks our architects to wrestle with the following essential questions as they experience the world of design.
